

BUBBLE LETTER AGREEMENT

This Bubble Letter Agreement (the “Agreement”) sets forth the terms and conditions under which the Sender agrees to deliver a bubble letter to the Recipient, representing a unique form of communication utilizing stylized bubble lettering. Both parties acknowledge the distinct nature of this correspondence and agree to engage with it in a manner consistent with this Agreement.

1. Definitions

“Bubble Letter” means stylized, inflated lettering often used for artistic or decorative purposes. “Sender” means the individual or entity composing and sending the Bubble Letter. “Recipient” means the individual or entity intended to receive and interpret the Bubble Letter.

2. Purpose

7. Confidentiality

Both parties agree to treat the content and existence of the Bubble Letter and this Agreement as confidential, except as required by law or agreed in writing. Disclosure to third parties requires prior written consent.

8. Governing Law and Jurisdiction

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of Canada. The parties irrevocably attorn to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of the appropriate provincial or federal courts of Canada for any dispute arising from this Agreement.

9. Entire Agreement

This Agreement constitutes the entire understanding between the parties concerning the Bubble Letter and supersedes all prior agreements, understandings, or representations. Any amendments must be in writing and signed by both parties.

10. Severability

If any provision of this Agreement is determined to be invalid or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

11. Counterparts and Execution

This Agreement may be executed in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, and all of which together shall constitute one and the same instrument. Signatures provided by electronic means, including PDF or image files, shall be deemed valid and binding.
