1. Introduction

This Agreement is made between the parties named above who have lived together in a conjugal relationship for a period of at least one year and intend to separate.

2. Acknowledgement of Common Law Relationship

The parties acknowledge that their relationship constitutes a common law partnership as defined under the laws of the Province of Canada applicable.

3. Separation Date

The parties agree that their separation date is the effective date specified above, and from this date they shall live separate and apart without cohabitation.

4. Property Division

The parties agree to divide their property, assets, and debts acquired during the relationship as set forth in this Agreement, subject to applicable laws including, but not limited to, the Family Property Act of the relevant Province.

5. Spousal Support

Neither party shall owe spousal support to the other except as expressly provided in this Agreement or as required under applicable provincial or federal laws.

6. Child Custody and Access

The parties agree on the custody and access arrangements for their children as specified herein, ensuring the best interests and welfare of the children are prioritized in accordance with the Divorce Act and provincial family laws.
