Scope of Services:

Designer agrees to provide interior design services including consultation, space planning, design development, selection of materials, furnishings, finishes, and overall project coordination as detailed in the attached Schedule A. Any additional services will require written agreement.

Project Timeline:

The estimated timeline for the completion of the design services shall be outlined in Schedule B. Designer shall use reasonable efforts to meet the agreed timeline but shall not be liable for delays caused by unforeseen circumstances or client changes.

Fees and Payment:

Client agrees to pay Designer fees as specified in Schedule C. Payment terms shall include a deposit upon execution of this Agreement, progress payments as milestones are met, and a final payment upon completion. All payments are non-refundable except as specifically set forth herein.

Client Responsibilities:

Client shall provide Designer with necessary access to premises, timely decisions, and approvals. Client agrees to review materials and provide feedback promptly to avoid delays.

Intellectual Property:

All design concepts, drawings, specifications, and related materials provided by Designer remain the intellectual property of Designer, except upon full payment by Client. Client is granted a license to use the designs for the specified project only.

Termination:

Either party may terminate this Agreement upon written notice if the other party breaches any material term and fails to cure within 14 days. Upon termination, Client shall pay Designer for services performed and reimbursable expenses incurred to date.

Limitation of Liability:

Designer's total liability under this Agreement shall not exceed the total fees paid by Client. Designer shall not be liable for indirect, special, consequential, or punitive damages.

Governing Law and Jurisdiction:

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of Canada and the applicable province or territory. The parties irrevocably submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts located within the relevant province or territory for any disputes arising under this Agreement.

Confidentiality:

Both parties agree to keep confidential all proprietary or sensitive information disclosed during the course of the project and to use such information solely for the purposes of performing obligations under this Agreement.

Force Majeure:

Neither party shall be liable for failure or delay in performance due to causes beyond their reasonable control, including but not limited to acts of God, governmental actions, labor disputes, or natural disasters.

Entire Agreement:

This Agreement, including all attached schedules and exhibits, constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and supersedes all prior negotiations and understandings. Any amendments must be in writing and signed by both parties.

Severability:

If any provision of this Agreement is found to be invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

Notices:

All notices required or permitted under this Agreement shall be in writing and delivered personally, by certified mail, or by a recognized courier service to the addresses set forth above or such other address as either party may designate by written notice.
