Recitals:

WHEREAS the parties desire to enter into a marriage agreement to define their rights, duties, and obligations during the marriage and upon its possible dissolution; AND WHEREAS the parties intend this Agreement to be legally binding and enforceable under the laws of Canada; NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants contained herein, the parties agree as follows.

Section 1 – Separate Property

Each party shall retain sole ownership, control, and enjoyment of all property owned by them prior to the marriage and any property acquired by gift, inheritance, or excluded by this Agreement. Neither party shall have any claim to the other's separate property.

Section 2 – Family Property

Property acquired jointly or during the marriage not specifically excluded shall be considered family property and divided equitably in accordance with applicable provincial laws upon dissolution.

Section 3 – Debts and Liabilities

Each party shall be responsible for their own debts and liabilities incurred before and during the marriage unless otherwise agreed. Joint debts shall be shared equally or as otherwise stipulated.

Section 4 – Spousal Support

The parties may waive or agree to spousal support arrangements consistent with Canadian law. Any waiver of support shall be made with full understanding of rights and obligations.

Section 5 – Disclosure

Each party confirms that they have made a full and fair disclosure of their financial circumstances and have had the opportunity to seek independent legal advice.

Section 6 – Independent Legal Advice

The parties acknowledge that they have been advised to obtain independent legal advice regarding this Agreement and

enter into it voluntarily, without duress or undue influence.

Section 7 – Term and Termination

This Agreement shall become effective upon execution by both parties and shall remain in force throughout the marriage unless amended or terminated in writing by mutual consent.

Section 8 – Governing Law

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the relevant Canadian province or territory where the parties reside.

Section 9 – Dispute Resolution

In the event of any dispute arising under this Agreement, the parties agree to attempt mediation prior to initiating court proceedings.

Section 10 – Entire Agreement

This document contains the entire agreement between the parties relating to the subject matter hereof and supersedes all prior agreements, understandings, or representations.

Section 11 – Amendments

Any amendments or modifications to this Agreement must be made in writing and signed by both parties to be effective.

Section 12 – Severability

If any provision of this Agreement is held invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall continue in full force and effect.

Section 13 – Execution

This Agreement may be executed in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, and all of which constitute one and the same instrument.

Section 14 – Acknowledgement

Each party acknowledges that they have read and understood this Agreement, have had the opportunity to ask questions, and agree to be bound by its terms.
