### Section 1 – Custody and Access

The parties agree that the child(ren) shall have shared custody, with parenting time and decision-making responsibilities allocated as follows. Both parents shall communicate and cooperate in the best interests of the child(ren). Access schedules, holidays, and special occasions shall be arranged with mutual agreement or as outlined in the attached schedule.

### Section 2 – Decision Making

Major decisions regarding the child(ren)'s education, health, religion, and welfare shall be made jointly by the parents. In the event of disagreement, the parties agree to attempt mediation before seeking court intervention.

### Section 3 – Child Support

Parent 1 and Parent 2 agree to provide financial support in accordance with the Federal Child Support Guidelines of Canada. The amount, payment frequency, and method are detailed in the attached child support schedule.

### Section 4 – Health Care and Insurance

Both parents shall maintain appropriate health insurance coverage for the child(ren). Medical, dental, psychological, and emergency care shall be provided as needed, with costs shared as agreed or as required by law.

### Section 5 – Education

The child(ren) shall attend school as agreed upon by both parents. Education decisions, including school choice and extracurricular activities, require mutual consent.

### Section 6 – Relocation

Neither parent shall relocate the child(ren) outside the Province of British Columbia without prior written consent from the other parent or a court order. Relocation includes any move that significantly impacts the child(ren)'s current living, schooling, or access arrangements.

### Section 7 – Dispute Resolution

In the event of disputes regarding this agreement, the parties agree first to seek resolution through mediation or family dispute resolution services before pursuing court action.

**Section 8 – Modification of Agreement**

This agreement may be modified only by mutual written consent of both parties or by order of a court having jurisdiction.

**Section 9 – Legal Compliance**

This agreement is intended to comply with and be enforceable under the laws of the Province of British Columbia and Canada. It reflects the parties’ intentions and best interests of the child(ren).

**Section 10 – Confidentiality**

The parties agree to keep all personal information and terms of this agreement confidential except when disclosure is required by law or for enforcement purposes.

**Section 11 – Acknowledgment**

Both parties acknowledge they have entered into this agreement freely, voluntarily, and with understanding of its terms and legal consequences. Each party has had the opportunity to obtain independent legal advice.

**Section 12 – Effective Date and Term**

This agreement shall become effective upon execution by both parties and shall remain in force until amended or replaced.
